Example of what Reading HW should
look like

Step 1: Write the title, setting, and main characters
- The title is The Boy Who Cried Wolf. The
setting is the village. The main characters
are the shepherd boy, the villagers, and
the wolf.

Step 2: Explain the problem in the story.
- The shepherd boy was bored so he
wanted to have fun.

Step 3: Explain ~~with~~ how the character

Step 4: Explain solution.

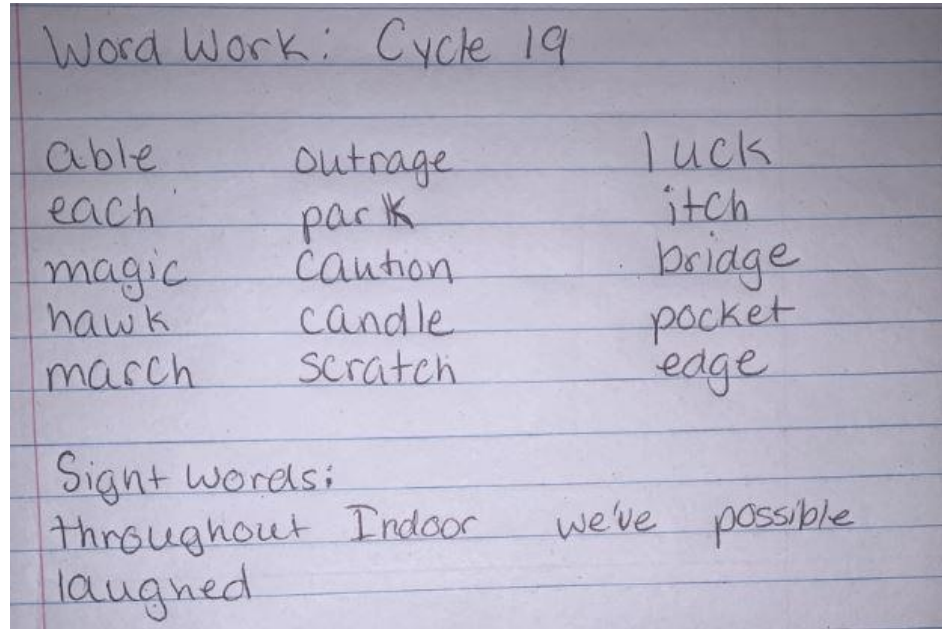
